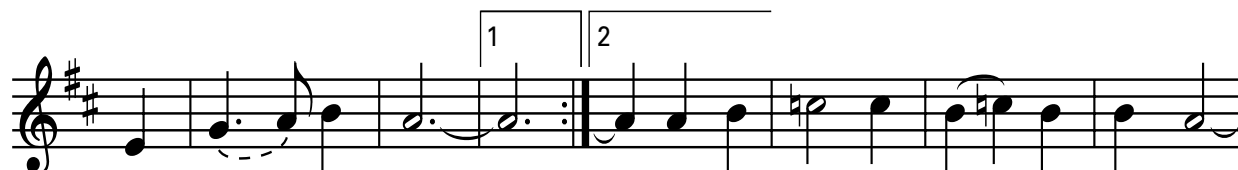

and asked that a murderer be released to you.

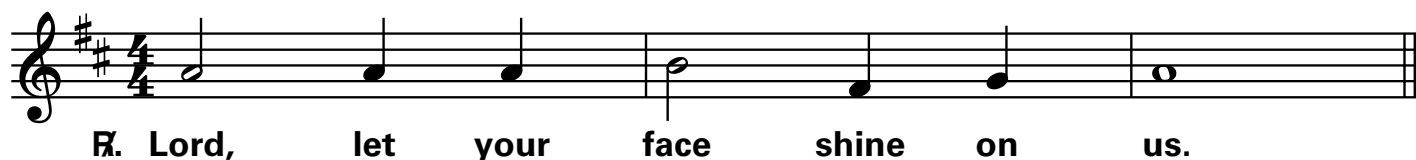
The author of life you put to death,

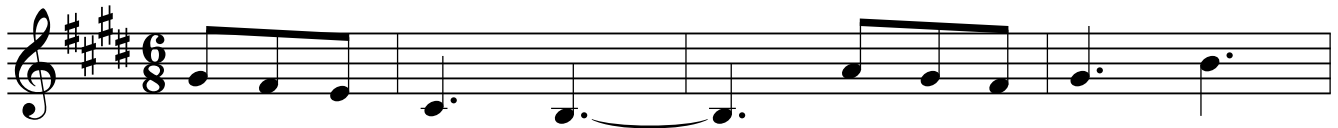

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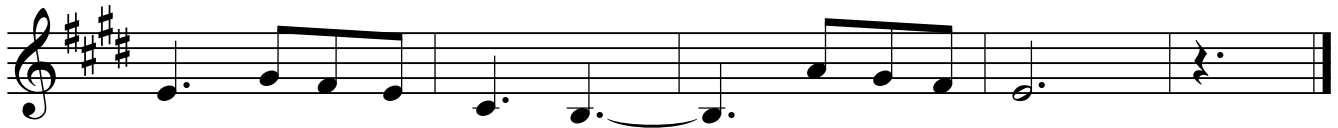

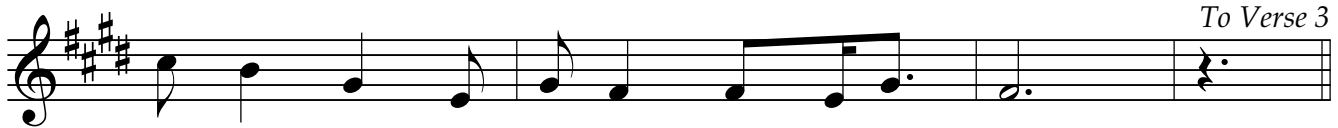
